**Coordinate PA** is part of the one call process and its power gives you the ability to track one call notifications, crosscheck tickets for permits, check facility owner responses and administer tickets.

To ensure projects are managed, Pennsylvania 811 Board of Directors has implemented all design notifications must be entered online into Coordinate PA. This enables project owners, designers, excavators, facility owners/operators and municipalities to safely manage and coordinate construction projects.

Where Coordinate PA excels is during complex project coordination. Meetings are scheduled before any excavation begins and all of the stakeholders have the ability to discuss the entire project, determine construction phases and agree upon a workable locating schedule.

All of the online tools Pennsylvania 811 develops are available for our stakeholders to use at no additional cost.

Our mission has not changed and more than ever we need influential parties to help promote safe digging practices and the use of 811 during the rebuild of roads, bridges and rails throughout the commonwealth.

Safe Digging Month is an awareness initiative sponsored by Pennsylvania 811 for the month of April. Traditionally outdoor projects start in the spring. Pennsylvania 811 Safe Digging Month serves as a reminder to all excavators and homeowners to contact 811 at least three business days before you dig, so that the approximate location of their underground utility lines can be identified and marked by facility owners. The contact 811 before you dig process helps to prevent injuries, property damage, and inconvenient utility outages.

#### WRITTEN COMMUNICATIONS

To make it easier when writing content for a press release, article or social media messaging, we have included prevalent information to include with your communications.

- The service is free to any homeowner working on their residential property
- A small fee applies for professional contractors per calendar year for unlimited use of the service
- Pennsylvania 811 does not locate underground lines
- A tolerance zone is the horizontal space within eighteen inches of the outside wall or edge of a line or facility
- Within the tolerance zone you must employ prudent techniques, which may include hand-dug test holes or vacuum excavation
- The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PA PUC) is the enforcement authority of PA Act 287 of 1974, as amended puc.pa.gov/pipeline/pa-one-call/
