To promote safety, we provide an efficient and effective communications network among project owners, designers, excavators, and facility owners within 67 counties, 24/7, 24 hours a day, every day each year.

With the passage of the Bipartisan Infrastructure law and the Broadband Equity, Access and Deployment Program, we anticipate an increase in projects throughout Pennsylvania that will impact the construction industry as well as the underground facility owners.

To ensure projects are efficiently managed, Pennsylvania 811 has developed a tool called Coordinate PA that enables project owners, designers and excavators to safely manage and coordinate their underground construction projects with underground facility owners and municipalities.

Our mission has not changed and we need influential parties to help promote safe digging during this rebuild of roads, bridges and rails.

INTRODUCTION

Safe Digging Month is an awareness initiative sponsored by Pennsylvania 811 for the month of April. Traditionally outdoor projects start in the spring. Pennsylvania 811 Safe Digging Month serves as a reminder to all excavators and homeowners to contact 811 at least three business days before you dig, so that the approximate location of their underground utility lines can be identified and marked by facility owners. The contact 811 before you dig process helps to prevent injuries, property damage, and inconvenient utility outages.

INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS WITH FEDERAL FUNDING

- Repair and rebuild roads and bridges Pennsylvania will receive \$11.3 billion for federal-aid highway apportioned programs and \$1.6 billion for bridge replacement and repairs
- Improve health, sustainable transportation options \$2.8 billion over five years to improve public transportation including improvements and expansion across the state
- Connect every Pennsylvanian to reliable high-speed internet \$100 million to help provide broadband coverage across the commonwealth
- Prepare more of our infrastructure for impactful events \$49 million over five years to protect against wildfires, \$26 million to protect against cyber-attacks, \$3.5 billion investment in weatherization to reduce energy costs for families
- **Deliver clean drinking water** \$1.4 billion over five years to improve water infrastructure
- Improve commonwealth airports \$355 million over five years

All of the infrastructure improvements involve digging.

WRITTEN COMMUNICATIONS

To make it easier when writing content for a press release, article or social media messaging, we have included prevalent information to include with your communications.

- Pennsylvania One Call System, Inc. dba Pennsylvania 811
- Pennsylvania 811 website is <u>pa1call.org</u>
- PA Act 287 of 1974, as amended or PA Act 287, as amended or Pennsylvania Underground Utility Line Protection Law (PA UULPL)
- Contact 811 at least three business days before digging
- Online locate request at least three business days before digging is pa1call.org/notify
- The service is free to any homeowner working on their residential property
- A small fee applies for professional contractors per calendar year for unlimited use of the service
- Pennsylvania 811 does not locate underground lines
- A tolerance zone is the horizontal space within eighteen inches of the outside wall or edge of a line or facility
- Within the tolerance zone you must employ prudent techniques, which may include hand-dug test holes or vacuum excavation
- The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PA PUC) is the enforcement authority of PA Act 287 of 1974, as amended puc.pa.gov/pipeline/pa-one-call/




PROCLAMATIONS, RESOLUTIONS AND LETTERS OF SUPPORT

Templates are available, for any of the following means of recognition, and when we receive it before the beginning of April 2023, we will post it on our social media channels. You may request a template from one of our Damage Prevention Liaisons at palcall.org/liaisons.

- A **proclamation** is a ceremonial document issued by Commissioners or Council to *commemorate a specific time* (day, week or month) for raising awareness about local efforts.
- A **resolution** is a ceremonial document that generally commends an organization for *service to the community* for a particular accomplishment.
- A **letter of support** offers recognition in collaboration with a *business* or organization's public awareness outreach efforts.
