

Complex Project Ticket Creation

Complex Project tickets are required when excavation involves more work than can properly be described in a single locate request which is 1,000 feet or intersection to intersection, whichever is greater, along the same street within the same political subdivision.

Additional data will be collected on Complex Project tickets. In order to capture more information to describe the work area when entering a Complex Project ticket through Coordinate PA you can now choose a Work Location Type of “Bounding Streets” or “Starting and Ending Points.”

Bounding Streets will display four street fields to enter the names of the streets surrounding the work area.
